THE BASICS

About the Space

Merrimac & Main operates out of an historic church, built in 1907, with some newer additions. Lovers of old architecture will appreciate the detailed doorknobs and intricate woodwork!

When you enter the glass doors on Main Street, you're on the ground level. Down the hall, you'll find some private offices and the grand Fellowship Hall, the Kitchen, the Cozy Room, and two bathrooms with stalls.

If you go up the stairs or the elevator to the Upper Level, you'll find the Sanctuary, nursery, Overflow Room, and two meeting rooms. All of us are enamored by the stained glass on this floor.



Accessibility

The glass door on Main Street has an ADA Push Button Door, with no steps. On the ground level are two spacious gendered bathrooms – these are not ADA compliant. There is an elevator to take guests to the upper level. Up here, there is a single bathroom with plenty of space.

Booking Policy & Process

- 1. Check out the options in this guide
- 2. Send an email to merrimacmain@gmail.com. Share as much information as you can, or ask to set up a phone call. It helps to know the date and time you are looking at, the room or rooms you have in mind, and any other information, such as A/V requests.
- 3. Stop by for a tour. Leave your deposit & get a key card.
- 4. Have your event.
- 5. Drop off your key card & get back your deposit.



Rate Overview

Beginning March 2025, we are launching two types of room rentals: basic & deluxe.

A **Basic** rental is bare-bones. We know that sometimes you just need a room, and want to keep it simple. We want to encourage people to host gatherings and so we're keeping our Basic rate as low as possible!

We also know that sometimes you want The Works – a little bit more privacy, some A/V equipment, some more flexibility with your space. This is our **Deluxe** package. There details about this on each room page!

THE SANCTUARY

Capacity 200+ Location Upper Level

Description

The Sanctuary is a grand and uniquely-shaped octagonal room with a definite "wow" factor. Three walls feature stained glass and a fourth features the grand old organ. High vaulted ceilings come together at a stained-glass peak in the center. There are rows of padded wood pews on both sides of a wide aisle, leading to the raised pulpit. There is a single bathroom just outside the doors.

This room is always "**Deluxe**". When you rent the Sanctuary, you can use your choice of hand-hold or stationary microphones and a large wall-mounted TV with HDMI-Cable hookup to a laptop and internet. Your guests can spill out into the Overflow Room and use the Nursery at no additional cost.

Rates \$140 (1-2 hours), \$230 (3-5 hours), \$300 (6+ hours)



FELLOWSHIP HALL

Capacity 100+ Location Lower Level

Description

The Fellowship Hall is our most popular room for rentals. Even on the Ground Floor, it boasts plenty of natural light through seven windows. This room is generally equipped with long tables and metal folding chairs & is very adaptive for large meetings/trainings, birthday parties, art classes, & much more.

Basic (\$50 1-2 hours, \$100 half-day, \$150 full-day)

Use this room (& this room only!) with only tables & chairs. It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$120 1-2 hours, \$180 half-day, \$240 full-day)

Feel free to set out food on the kitchen counter, use the oven to heat things up, store some food in the fridge, and clean up with the sink. Nobody else will be in the Lower Level (besides staff in their offices), but another group might be upstairs. You also get to use a portable microphones, speakers, a flat-screen TV with HMDI cable and laptop, a projector and screen, and tablecloths.



THE KITCHEN

Capacity 20 Location Lower Level

Description

The Kitchen was specially designed for pasty-making parties! There are two commercial ovens, a stainless-steel sink, fridge, standard oven, and ample counterspace. Maybe you want to do a bunch of holiday baking?

Basic (\$40 1-2 hours, \$80 half-day, \$120 full-day)

Use the fridge, counters, and standard oven in this room. It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$80 1-2 hours, \$120 half-day, \$160 full-day)

In addition to the basics, you also get to use the two large commercial ovens, our canning equipment, and a thermal laser printer that's designed specifically for label-making. Start your own Cottage Food Business right out of the M&M kitchen! It's no big deal if your kids want to tag along and hang out in the Cozy Room or the Fellowship Hall – nobody else will be downstairs with you.



THE COZY ROOM

Capacity 30 Location Lower Level

Description

The Cozy Room is where we host the after-school program on Wednesday evenings. It has carpeted floors, a comfy couch, rug, coffee table, and some fun chairs – and some nice natural light and a fresh coat of paint!

Basic (\$40 1-2 hours, \$80 half-day, \$120 full-day) Use the room just as it is! It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$80 1-2 hours, \$120 half-day, \$160 full-day)

Use the projector and screen for a fun movie night, or borrow the TV, HDMI Cable, and Laptop for a presentation. We even have yoga mats that you can borrow. Feel free to serve food on the kitchen counter, heat things up in the oven, store food in the fridge, and use the sink for clean-up. Nobody else will be downstairs while you're there!

OVERFLOW ROOM

Capacity 30 Location Upper Level

Description

This space is called the Overflow Room because it used to open up to the Sanctuary for really crowded events! It has since been closed off, and now serves as a welcoming space with tall ceilings, wood floors, and tiny stage.

Basic (\$30 1-2 hours, \$45 half-day, \$60 full-day)

Use the room just as it is, or with basic tables and chairs! It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$50 1-2 hours, \$65 half-day, \$80 full-day)

Use the projector and screen, a flat-screen TV, HDMI Cable, and Laptop, or a microphone and speakers. We even have yoga mats that you can borrow. Feel free to let kids play in the nursery! Nobody else will be upstairs while you're here.



MEETING ROOM 1

Capacity 16 Location Upper Level

Description

This spacious meeting room has wood floors, three stained-glass windows, a chalkboard, and built-in shelving. It is usually set up with a table and chairs (10 people), but can accommodate more. It was used once as an art studio!

Basic (\$30 1-2 hours, \$45 half-day, \$60 full-day, \$400/month) Use the room just as it is! It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$50 1-2 hours, \$65 half-day, \$80 full-day)

Use the projector and screen, a flat-screen TV, HDMI Cable, and Laptop, or a microphone and speakers. Feel free to let kids play in the nursery or set up some snacks in the Overflow Room! Nobody else will be upstairs while you're here.

MEETING ROOM 2

Capacity 12 Location Upper Level

Description

This meeting room has wood floors, a stained-glass window, a chalkboard, and a fun Noah's Ark border! It is usually set up with a table and chairs (6 people), but can accommodate more.

Basic (\$30 1-2 hours, \$45 half-day, \$60 full-day, \$200/month) Use the room just as it is! It is possible that other guests will be in other rooms nearby.

Deluxe (\$50 1-2 hours, \$65 half-day, \$80 full-day)

Use the projector and screen, a flat-screen TV, HDMI Cable, and Laptop, or a microphone and speakers. Feel free to let kids play in the nursery or set up some snacks in the Overflow Room! Nobody else will be upstairs while you're here.

THE NURSERY

Capacity ?? Kids are small! Location Upper Level

Description

This nursery is set up for kids O–5, approximately. It is stocked with plenty of toys, games, and more books than we need! Take some with you! There's a small sink, changing table, and rocking chair too.

There's not really a way to make this room deluxe -- it's just a simple, sweet, beautiful space with some of the best lighting in the whole building, from two stained-glass windows. We know most kids just love the chance to play with something different, and we've had playgroups meet up here! Feel free to bring in drinks and snacks.

Rates \$15 1-2 hours, \$20 half-day, \$30 full-day

EXPECTATIONS



Deposits

In order to secure your reservation, you must drop off a deposit, which will be somewhere between \$20 and \$200, depending on the details of your event.

If you clean up after yourself and everything is in good working order, the deposit will be returned.

If we need to pay a cleaning crew, we will deduct \$25/hour from the deposit.

When we say "clean up", we don't mean a deep, intense clean -- just throw away your trash, sweep up any spills, and wipe up any sticky spots. We don't expect perfection, but the space should be usable for the next person.

Communication

Merrimac & Main is a humble operation. Our Building Coordinator only works about 5-10 hours a week. We're sorry in advance that we can't be more quick with our responses - please be prepared for a short delay!

Be Courteous

If you are sharing the building with other guests, please be thoughtful about noise and wandering humans!

Supervised Youth

For Merrimac & Main Programming, we require that no adult should be behind a closed door with a minor alone. We always keep doors open, or have at least two adults available. When you're renting, we don't require this -- but highly encourage you to keep your kids & other kids safe!

Free, Public Events, Within Our Mission

If you want to host something that aligns with our mission, and you can offer it free and open-to-the-public as an official Merrimac & Main event, there is no cost to you. We'll help advertise & promote! Contact us about your ideas!

If you are an <u>organization</u> offering free, open-to-the-public events that align with our mission, we ask that you please consider a contribution to Merrimac & Main equal to about half of the normal room rental, if you are able. We are a nonprofit organization relying on donations, grants, and program fees to pay our bills. We pay rent to Plymouth UCC, which includes our utilities, internet, and cleaning fees, in addition to administrative and publicity costs, so we appreciate your support in defraying these costs.



Classes & Concerts

Are you a musician, a yoga instructor, an art teacher, or have another skill you'd like to share with others? We have three options for how you use our space for your programming:

- 1.**M&M Ticketed Event.** We create an event on our website, manage the registration, promote it through our normal networks as a M&M event. We take \$100 (class) or \$200 (concert) off the total income, and you get the rest. This means that if you sell 30 tickets at \$20/each, we keep \$100 and you get the remaining \$200.
- 2. **M&M Donation-Based Event.** We create an event on our website & promote it through normal networks. You collect donations at the door, and give <u>half</u> of donations to M&M, <u>up to</u> the \$100 / \$200 threshhold.
- 3. **Private Event.** This is all you! You rent the space at our normal rates, and you can publicize the event through your own channels!
